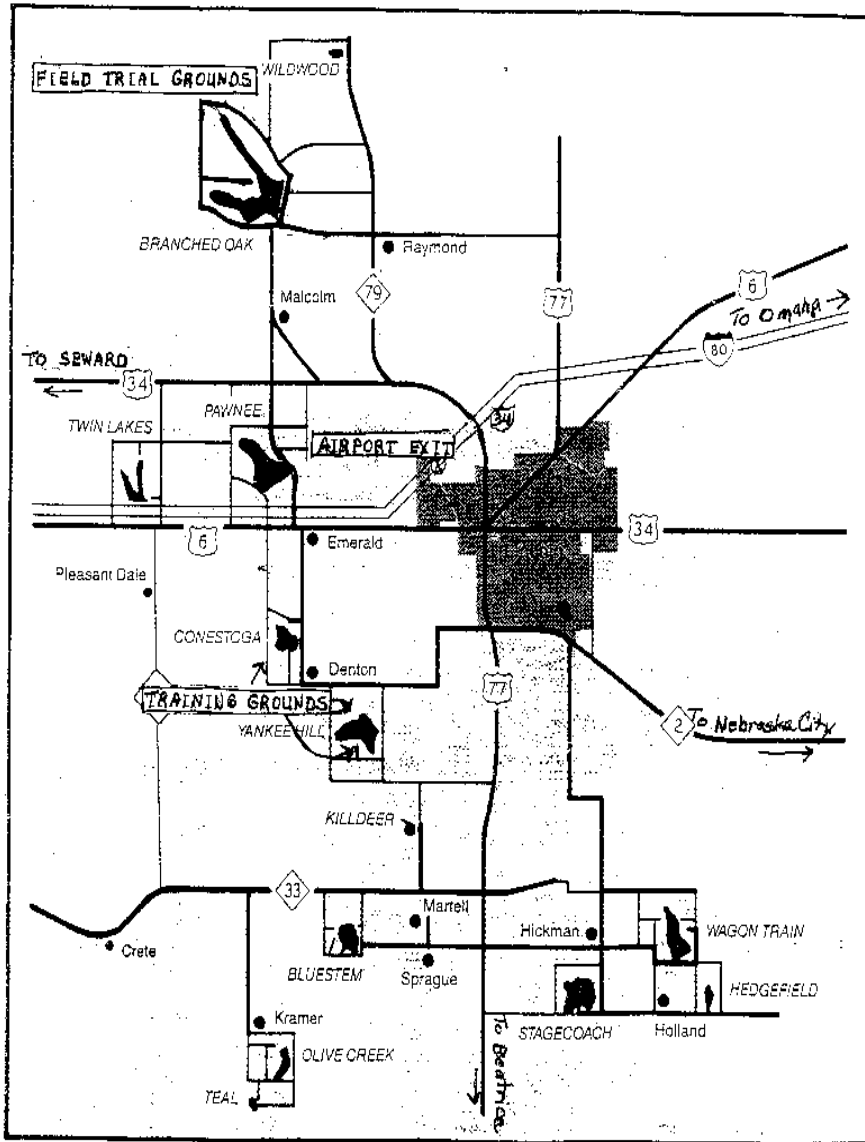

Open Puppy & Amateur Walking Puppy: Single course with no birds released.

Amateur All-Age, Open Limited Gun Dog, & Amateur Limited Gun Dog: Are retrieving stakes.

Quail and/or chukar will be used in all stakes except Puppy.

A blank cartridge will not be fired in the Puppy Stakes.

Horseback Handling will be permitted in all stakes except Amateur Walking Puppy & Amateur Walking Derby.

AKC Approved Tracking Collars permitted.

Motels: at Lincoln, NE, located within 15-20 minutes from the grounds

Directions to the Trial Grounds: From Interstate 80, take Exit 401 to Exit 401B, US-34 W, & go 4.5 miles NW of Lincoln. Turn right (north) on NE-79 & go 5 miles. Turn left (west) on West Raymond Road & go 3 miles. Take a right at the Branched Oak Sign & follow the blacktop over the dam and around the lake for 5 miles. The field trial grounds are located at the Northwest corner of the lake. The entrance is on your left, marked with a sign.

Camping: Overnight camping is allowed on the grounds. There is a \$3.00 charge for electrical hook-ups – payable to the Field Trial Chairman. Showers are located in nearby park facilities. State park stickers will be required to use park facilities outside of the field trial grounds. Please clean up after your animals in the camping area.

Food: Breakfast and lunch will be served daily in the Field Trial Clubhouse.

Training: Dog training is not permitted on the grounds. Training grounds for amateurs only are located southwest of Lincoln at Yankee Hill.

Horses: Horses will not be available. For those of you bringing your own horses, pens are available on a first come, first served basis. There are also designated stakeout areas for horses.

Entries: Telephone entries are NOT accepted. All entries must be completed in full and fees MUST be paid to the Field Trial Secretary before the entry closing time.
